POSITION: TEACHER

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Michigan Teacher certification
- At least 3 years teaching experience (formal or informational setting)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

In addition to those responsibilities listed in the CAMP BURT SHURLY JOB DESCRIPTIONS OVERVIEW, each Teacher should:

1. DPS Camp Burt Shurly teacher will be responsible for 1 week of instruction. Curriculum will be provided, however, teacher may also include their own additional elements.
2. Training on the curriculum is required prior to camp.
3. There will be 2 teachers hired per week, and they should work collaboratively.
4. Teacher will be expected to utilize the outdoor features of camp to the maximum for instruction.
5. Science is the main focus of the educational experience, however, literacy, mathematics, and social studies should be integrated.
6. Teacher should have proficiency relative to classroom management, student engagement, differentiated instruction, and hands-on learning.
7. Teachers are encouraged, but not required, to participant/show support in camp meals, talent show and other activities with campers and staff to help reinforce the camp culture.

PHYSICAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

1. Due to the fact that the camp is in an outdoor setting, the teacher should be physically fit enough to walk distances on uneven ground (all cars/trucks will be parked at the beginning of the week and not driven around camp)
2. Ability to move items that are up to 10 pounds
